Voted unanimously to accept February minutes.

Signed hay lease with Dave Baker and he presented check for \$600 (to be deposited in the general conservation fund) and list of improvements he has made to the fields (see attached).

Commission voted unanimously to pay Dave Baker \$600 for services rendered to improve the Potter hay fields and trails.

Held public hearing for Article 11 in town hall. 16 people attended.

Discussed motion to advance article 11 and strategy for Town meeting presentation.

Cathy read the proposal for the vascular plant survey to be done in May, June, Aug. & Sept. 2013! Bob L will be liaison with the New England Wildflower Society for maps and billing.

Commission voted unanimously to have the botanical survey of quarry land and 4 adjacent parcels by the New England Wildflower Society. This will cost \$6,568 which will be paid for by an anonymous donor.

Title insurance discussion cannot be resolved until we meet with the selectmen.

Time to order timbers for the trestle rebuild. We agreed if Currier provides the timbers, they would be delivered on demand by Eric.

Commission voted unanimously to pay our dues to the NH Assoc. of Conservations Commissions total \$210 (attached).

Commission voted unanimously to reimburse Bob Dillberger for reprographic services (Fedex) which total \$76.44 (attached).
